14	modifying, and approving the budgets of ACOs with 10,000 or more attributed
15	lives in Vermont. To the extent permitted under federal law, the Board shall
16	ensure the rules anticipate and accommodate a range of ACO models and sizes,
17	balancing oversight with support for innovation. In its review, the Board shall
18	review and consider:

20	(N) the effect, if any, of Medicaid reimbursement rates on the rates
21	for other payers; and

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1	(O) the extent to which the ACO makes its costs transparent and easy
2	to understand so that patients are aware of the costs of the health care services
3	they receive; and
4	(P) the extent to which the ACO provides resources to primary care
5	practices to ensure that care coordination and community services, such as
6	mental health and substance use disorder counseling that are provided by
7	community health teams are available to patients without imposing
8	unreasonable burdens on primary care providers or on ACO member
9	organizations; recognizing that recommendations to enhance integration
10	between social service providers and the ACO, if care coordination and
11	Unified Community Collaborative activities are provided in collaboration with
12	a designated or specialized service agency, that the agency shall be reimbursed
13	through payment from the ACO for those services.
