5 Subject: Solid waste; universal recycling; food residuals; deadline

6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to extend by one
7 year the date by which any person who generates food residuals is required to
8 separate food residuals from solid waste and manage the food residuals on his
9 or her or its property or arrange for the transfer of the food residuals to a
10 facility that manages food residuals.

11 An act relating to the management of food residuals

12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. 10 V.S.A. § 6605k(c) is amended to read:

14 (c) The following persons shall be subject to the requirements of subsection
15 (b) of this section:

16 (1) beginning on July 1, 2014, a person whose acts or processes produce
17 more than 104 tons per year of food residuals;

18 (2) beginning on July 1, 2015, a person whose acts or processes produce
19 more than 52 tons per year of food residuals;

1 (3) beginning on July 1, 2016, a person whose acts or processes produce
2 more than 26 tons per year of food residuals;

3 (4) beginning on July 1, 2017, a person whose acts or processes produce
4 more than 18 tons per year of food residuals; and

5 (5) beginning on July 1, ~~2020~~ 2021, any person who generates any
6 amount of food residuals.

7 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

8 This act shall take effect on passage.
