13	each year. In making these appointments, the Governor and the Senate shall
14	give consideration to experience, expertise, or skills relating to the
15	environment or land use environmental science, natural resources law and
16	policy, land use planning, community planning, environmental justice, or racial
17	equity.
18	(A) The Governor shall appoint a chair of the Board, a position that
19	shall be a full-time position. The Governor shall ensure, to the extent possible,
20	that the Board membership reflects the racial, ethnic, gender, and geographic
21	diversity of the State.

4	§ 6026. DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS
5	(a) For the purposes of the administration of this chapter, the State is
6	divided into nine districts.

8	(b) A District Environmental Commission is created for each district. Each
9	District Commission shall consist of three members from that district
10	appointed in the month of February by the Governor so that two appointments
11	expire in each odd-numbered year. Two of the members shall be appointed for
12	a term of four years, and the Chair (third member) of each District shall be
13	appointed for a two-year four-year term. In any district, the Governor may
14	appoint not more than four up to two alternate members from that district
15	whose terms shall not exceed two years, who may hear any case when a
16	regular member is disqualified or otherwise unable to serve. The Governor
17	shall ensure, to the extent possible, that appointments are made in a timely
18	manner and that each District Commission reflects the racial, ethnic, gender,

3	§ 6027. POWERS
4	(a) The Board and District Commissions shall have supervisory authority in
5	environmental matters respecting projects within their jurisdiction and shall
6	apply their independent judgment in determining facts and interpreting law.
7	They each shall have the power, with respect to any matter within its
8	jurisdiction, to:
9	(1) administer oaths, take depositions, subpoena and compel the
10	attendance of witnesses, and require the production of evidence;
11	(2) allow parties to enter upon lands of other parties for the purposes of
12	inspecting and investigating conditions related to the matter before the Board
13	or Commission;
14	(3) enter upon lands for the purpose of conducting inspections,
15	investigations, examinations, tests, and site evaluations as it deems necessary
16	to verify information presented in any matter within its jurisdiction; and
17	(4) apply for and receive grants from the federal government and from
18	other sources.
19	(b) The powers granted under this chapter are additional to any other
20	powers which that may be granted by other legislation.

2	(1) hear appeals of a determination by a regional planning commission
3	as to the sufficiency of municipal bylaws pursuant to subdivision
4	6001(3)(A)(xi) of this title;
5	(2) hear appeals of a determination by the Downtown Development
6	Board designating a downtown development district, a village center that has
7	received enhanced designation, or neighborhood development area pursuant to
8	24 V.S.A. chapter 76A; and
9	(3) approve regional plans pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 4348.
