## Distracted Driving Laws - Penalties, Points, and Suspensions

## **Suspensions:**

- An adult operator who accumulates 10 points or more from traffic violations within a two-year period is subject to a 10-day suspension, with increasing suspension times for each additional five points.<sup>10</sup>
- Learner's permits and junior operator's licenses are subject to a 90-day recall after six points are accumulated.<sup>11</sup>
- Learner's permits and junior operator's licenses are subject to a 30-day recall after one texting conviction. 12
- Texting or using a handheld mobile telephone while driving is a "serious traffic violation" under the CDL law. <sup>13</sup> Two serious traffic violations within a three-year period triggers a 60-day suspension from operating a commercial motor vehicle, and three or more serious traffic violations within a three-year period triggers a 120-day suspension from operating a commercial motor vehicle. <sup>14</sup>
