17	(C) the type of search conducted, if any;
18	(D) the evidence located, if any;
19	(E) the outcome of the traffic stop, including whether:

21	(ii) a citation for a civil ticket was issued;

1	(iii) a citation or arrest for a misdemeanor or a felony occurred; or
2	(iv) no subsequent action was taken;
3	(F) summary data broken out by age, gender, race, and outcome of
4	the traffic stop where the reason for the stop was the primary enforcement of a
5	person 18 years of age or over not wearing a safety belt; and
6	(G) summary data broken out by age, gender, race, and outcome of
7	the traffic stop where the reason for the stop was for any reason other than the
8	primary enforcement of a person 18 years of age or over not wearing a safety
9	<u>belt.</u>
