Suspensions:

- An adult operator who accumulates 10 points or more from traffic violations within a two-year period is subject to a 10-day suspension, with increasing suspension times for each additional five points.¹³
- Learner's permits and junior operator's licenses are subject to a 90-day recall after six points are accumulated.¹⁴
- Learner's permits and junior operator's licenses are subject to a 30-day recall after one texting conviction. 15
- Texting or using a handheld mobile telephone while driving is a "serious traffic violation" under the CDL law. ¹⁶ Two serious traffic violations within a three-year period triggers a 60-day suspension from operating a commercial motor vehicle, and three or more serious traffic violations within a three-year period triggers a 120-day suspension from operating a commercial motor vehicle. ¹⁷
