14	(a) Except as otherwise provided, snowmobiles, trailer coaches as defined
15	by 23 V.S.A. § 4 registered yearly for use on the highways and designed and
16	used for recreational purposes except as provided by subsection (b) of this
17	section recreation, canoes, skiffs, sailboats, motor or power boats, boats,
18	outboard motors, or any combination of boat and outboard motor, shall be
19	taxed as personal property only when held as stock in trade, manufacturer's

1	inventory, or when used for income producing purposes, and in such cases
2	shall be set in the list in accordance with section 3691 of this title.
3	(b) A trailer coach shall be taxed as real property by the town in which it is
4	located notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section if it is situated in the
5	town on the same trailer site or camp site for more than 180 days during the
6	365 days prior to April 1. A trailer coach shall not be taxed as real property if it
7	is stored on property on which the owner resides in another dwelling as a
8	permanent residence.
9	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
10	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019 and apply to grand lists lodged
11	after that date.
