7	Sec. 1. REACH UP AND REACH AHEAD PILOT PROGRAM		
8	In fiscal year 2020, the Department for Children and Families shall provide		
9	the Good News Garage with an additional \$434.00, beyond the \$6,000.00		
10	purchase price, for each personal car purchased by the Department for a		
11	participant in the Reach Up or Reach Ahead programs. The \$434.00 shall be		
12	transferred by the Good News Garage to the participant in the Reach Up or		
13	Reach Ahead program for whom the Department purchased the personal car to		
14	cover the costs of the motor vehicle sales and use tax pursuant to 32 V.S.A.		
15	§ 8903 and the registration fee for the first year pursuant to 23 V.S.A. § 361.		
16	Sec. 2. REACH UP AND REACH AHEAD PILOT PROGRAM REPORT		
17	The Department for Children and Families, in consultation with the Good		
18	News Garage and the Departments of Motor Vehicles and of Taxes, shall file a		
19	written report on the pilot program established in Sec. 1 of this act with the		
20	House Committee on Human Services and the Senate Committee on Health		
21	and Welfare on or before March 1, 2020. The report shall address the number		

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1	of personal cars purchased by the Department for Children and Families for
2	participants in the Reach Up and Reach Ahead programs in fiscal year 2020
3	through January 31, 2020, the number of those personal cars subsequently
4	registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles, whether the sales and use
5	tax was paid on each of those personal cars, any difficulties or successes with
6	the implementation of the pilot program, and anything else the Department for
7	Children and Families wishes to address.
8	Sec. 3. SPENDING AUTHORITY
9	The Department for Children and Families is authorized to spend
10	\$26,040.00 from any vacancy savings associated with bringing on new
11	employees in the Family Services Division in fiscal year 2020 for the purpose
12	of implementing the pilot program established in Sec. 1 of this act.
13	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
14	This act shall take effect on passage.
15	and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: "An act relating
16	to the Reach Up and Reach Ahead pilot program"
