Line Notes on differences House vs Senate

9 AOT Buildings

Senate: Lunenburg garage construction delayed. \$25,000 provided for engineering

12 Public Transit

Senate: \$500,000 added for Transit Demand Management grants

13 Aviation

- (1) Senate: Clarendon airport SRE building (to house specialized snow removal vehicle): Construction delayed; funding cut \$530,000, leaving \$65,000 needed to modify a district garage space as a temporary storage site.
- (2) Senate: Morrisville fuel farm: New exigent project arising in Jun. Construction funding increased by \$230,000 to a total of \$380,000 to cover costs ineligible for FAA funding.

14 Pedestrian & Bike Facilities

- (1) House used \$700,000 in TF to fund Lamoille Valley Rail Trail construction. Senate covers same amount in the capital bill
- (2) Senate: Grants for town projects increased by \$100,000 TF requiring \$100,000 local match. Local match is not appropriated and thus not included in total spending

Net Senate vs House thus -\$700,000 + \$100,000 = -\$600,000

21 Maintenance

(1) House cut \$1.3 million. Senate restored \$700,000 of the cut (not needed to fund LVRT)

21 EV Purchase Incentives

Senate adds \$50,000 to cover extra administrative costs
