

**Proposed House Education Committee Spending: Draft 3.1 June 10, 2020**

*Reminder: the CARES Act and U.S. Department of the Treasury (U.S. Treasury) guidance say that payments from the Fund may only be used to cover costs that:*

1. are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
2. were not accounted for in the budget most recently approved as of March 27, 2020 (the date of enactment of the CARES Act) for the State or government;
3. were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020 and ends on December 30, 2020

**Tier 1: \$50M**

<b>\$5</b>	Higher education support: \$2M UVM, \$3M VSC	TBD by HAC

**Tier 2: \$75M**
