15	IN-STATE TUITION ELIGIBILITY
16	(a)(1) The Vermont Student Assistance Corporation shall administer a
17	program to provide a State education award that matches the federal Segal
18	AmeriCorps education award to a student who provided his or her AmeriCorps
19	service in Vermont and is enrolled at Northern Vermont University, Castleton
20	University, or Vermont Technical College.

1	(2) The Corporation shall adopt policies, procedures, and guidelines
2	necessary to verify a student's eligibility and the amount of his or her federal
3	education award.
4	(3) The Corporation's duties under this section are subject to the
5	appropriation of funds by the General Assembly specifically for this purpose.
6	(b) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, a student who is a
7	past or present AmeriCorps service member in Vermont shall be eligible for
8	in-state tuition rates at Vermont State colleges and universities.
9	Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION
10	In fiscal year 2020, the amount of \$200,000.00 is appropriated from the
11	General Fund to the Vermont Student Assistance Corporation to provide
12	matching State education awards pursuant to 16 V.S.A. § 2886.
13	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
14	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
