Population Analysis January 17, 2019 Snapshot

Introduction

The Department of Corrections records criminal offenses in its Offender Management System (OMS). Each offense is entered separately and coded by offense type group for analysis. The offense types are ordered by severity (01 most serious – 11 least serious) and by Felony (F) or Misdemeanor (M).

The data in the following tables does not contain any inmate¹ held for the Federal Marshalls. All the detained and sentenced inmates in the study are Vermont offenders. Sentenced data includes inmates housed at the Supplemental Housing Facility in Mississippi.

Population Analysis

The information in the tables below are from a point in time review of the incarcerated population on January 17, 2019. The DOC uses point in time analysis to monitor the population. It compares similar points in time by month and year to observe changes.

Table 1 shows the number and percent of inmates by offense type and status (detained or sentenced). A person will only be counted once in this table and will be listed in the most serious offense type category for which they are detained or sentenced.

Table 1 Analysis:

• 61% of detained inmates are charged with a SERIOUS FELONY

¹ 28 VSA § 3 (5) "Inmate" means any person, not a child, committed to the custody of the Commissioner pursuant to the law of the State and subsequently committed to a correctional facility and any person confined at a correctional facility during the pendency of a prosecution against him.

Population Analysis January 17, 2019 Snapshot

- 58% of sentenced inmates have been convicted of a SERIOUS FELONY
- 6% of detained inmates are charged with a MISDEMEANOR PERSON (see table 5 for breakdown)
- 82% of all inmates are held for the top 3 most serious crime groups
- 15% of all inmates are held for a FELONY PROPERTY Crime (see Table 4 for a breakdown)
- 6% of all inmates are held for misdemeanor crimes

Table 2 Analysis:

- 77% of inmates are sentenced
- 23% of inmates are detained
- Detained inmates charged with a SERIOUS FELONY comprise 14% of all inmates
- Sentenced inmates with a SERIOUS FELONY comprise 45% of all inmates

Table 3 shows a breakdown of the SERIOUS FELONY Group by legal status. Crime groups contain subcategories of the crime which are defined in statute. Attempts and Accessories are grouped within the same crime (i.e. Attempted murder grouped with Murder)

- 55% of inmates in the felony serious group are held for Aggravated Crimes (Assaults, Domestic Assaults, Sexual Assault)
- 18% of all inmates in the felony serious group are held for Sexual Assaults
- 11% of all inmates in the felony serious group are held for Murders
