18	amounts, and information concerning the purpose and use of any reserve funds,	
19	and debt service amounts for school construction.

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1	Sec. 3. STATE AID FOR SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION; STUDY; REPORT
2	(a) The Secretary of Education and the State Treasurer shall create a school
3	capital needs assessments survey and analyze options for the State to assist in
4	funding school construction projects. The analysis shall consider:
5	(1) various funding options, including through grants, loans and bonds;
6	(2) whether to limit the scope of eligible project costs; and
7	(3) what cost-share amount would be sustainable for the State.
8	(b) On or before January 15, 2020, the Secretary of Education and the State
9	Treasurer shall submit a written report to the House Committees on
10	Corrections and Institutions and on Education, and the Senate Committees on
11	Education and on Institutions. The report shall include recommendations for:
12	(1) a plan for distributing and maximizing response rates to the survey
13	described in subsection (a) of this section; and
14	(2) a legislative proposal for funding school construction projects based
15	on the analysis described in subsection of this section.
16	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATES
17	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019, except that Sec. 1 shall take effect
18	<u>on July 1, 2022.</u>
