### **Permits**

1. CPG, treated like a ground mount in a field.

2. State Electrical: requires electrical PE stamp, review and state approval

3. State Building: requires structural PE stamp, review and state approval



### **CPG**

- ANR, wetlands?
- ANR, storm water?
- DHP?
- Department of Agriculture, prime ag soils?
- Aesthetics, appropriate to have a parking canopy over a parking lot?
- All abutters
- Town boards



## Cost, Delay, and Recommendation

Cost: \$15,000 - 30,000

Time: 6-12 months

- If there is any objection during the 45 day notice period, it would go to hearing and the permit costs and time would at least double.

- A registration, with town notification and comment period, would meaningfully reduce unnecessary permitting costs and duration, and allow for local input.
- Legislature could prescribe a permitting process substantially the same as a rooftop installation, with the addition of the town being notified at CPG submittal, with the same 30 day comment period as the utility and other parties receive.
