6	(a)(1) The Board of Liquor and Lottery may grant a manufacturer's or
7	rectifier's license upon application and payment of the fee provided in section
8	204 of this title that permits the license holder to operate a facility that
9	manufacture manufactures or rectify rectifies:
10	(1)(A) malt beverages;
11	(2)(B) vinous beverages and fortified wines; or
12	(3)(C) spirits and fortified wines.
