Here is the list of proposed expenditures that should be included as “Tier 2” expenditures. The appropriations would be conditional based upon availability of funds and eligibility via Treasury guidelines, and could be approved by the Joint Fiscal Committee at an appropriate time.

GHMA may need to revisit this language over the summer or in August, when we return, to adjust for current realities. This may be handled by the flexibility inherent in the draft language you are developing.

TIER 2

\$15.5 mil in additional funding for rental assistance/eviction protection, if need is reflected;

\$3 mil additional funding for rehabilitation of homeless shelters in order to make them CDC-compliant;

\$3 mil for Enhanced VHIP if need is reflected;

\$3 mil for Foreclosure protection if need is reflected;

\$500,000 for development of statewide rental registry, in order to prepare for statewide housing safety program;

\$15 million for SERVICE COMPONENTS: If ruled eligible, service components should be budgeted here to include wraparound services and rental subsidies;

\$10 million [for services to provide food or other living expenses for Vermonters who are experiencing homelessness during the COVID-19 emergency.]
