Following on the Commissioner's testimony last week, you had additional clarifying questions.

We are working on providing the requested information regarding the Holiday Inn lease and Harbor Place contract. That information will be forthcoming as soon as possible.

Regarding the General Assistance motel voucher program, the Committee had asked:

- In his testimony, Ken referred to "households". What's the simple definition of household? A household is the unique unit of people housed together e.g., a single individual with no children, two adults living together, two parents with children, etc. This is a contrast with "people" as in the total number of people in emergency housing (regardless of household composition).
- What is the total number of units being rented through the voucher program?
 The total number of rooms occupied under the motel voucher program were
 1407 as of this morning.
- Can you provide a list of the facilities, or locations where the vouchers are being used? Can you break it down by county, or town? Please see the attached GA Motel Summary for a list of motels currently being used and broken down by ESD District Office service area.

We hope that this information is helpful and will continue working to provide the remainder of your request as quickly as we can. In the meantime, please let us know if you have any additional questions.
