My testimony has been submitted, it is not highly specific to the bill but more about Good Sams situation.

We do have several employees that are self-isolating and, I think, will benefit from the sick time benefits discussed. Due to restructuring due to our emergency move we have one employee who is laid off.

I am also concerned about workers compensation I understand that the state reviews these claims. If one of my workers becomes ill it will be difficult to know where they contacted the virus. Although it may be likely they contacted it as first responders for the homeless, I am hoping the state will use some flexibility and judgement in reviewing these claims . Please consider this as additional testimony.

Regarding the Housing bill, it looks very very important and I fully support it.
