10	entirety and renumbering the remaining subdivisions to be numerically correct.
11	<u>Third</u> : In Sec. 1, legislative intent, in subdivision (c)(3) after " <u>mental health</u>
12	issues;" by inserting and and by striking out subdivision (c)(4) in its entirety
13	and renumbering the remaining subdivision to be numerically correct.
14	Fourth: In Sec. 7, 20 V.S.A. § 1818, after "on his or her person" by
15	inserting the words and that the device is recording whenever the officer has
16	contact with the public for law enforcement purposes
17	Fifth: In Sec. 8, Department of Public Safety; video recording devices;
18	ongoing costs, after "initiate the acquisition" by inserting the words and
19	<u>deployment</u>
20	Sixth: In Sec. 8, Department of Public Safety; video recording devices;
21	ongoing costs, in the second sentence, by striking out "FY22 budget proposal

1	to the General Assembly" and inserting in lieu thereof FY21 budget proposal
2	to the General Assembly in August of 2020
3	Seventh: By striking out Sec. 9 and its reading assistance heading in their
4	entireties and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
5	* * * Repeal and Effective Dates * * *
6	Sec. 9. REPEAL
7	13 V.S.A. § 2305(3) (justifiable homicide) is repealed on July 1, 2021.
8	Eighth: In Sec. 10, effective dates, by striking out subsections (c) and (d) in
9	their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
10	(c) Sec. 6 (law enforcement use of prohibited restraint) shall take effect on
11	October 1, 2020.
12	(d) Sec. 7 (equipment of officers with video recording devices) shall take
13	effect on August 1, 2020.
14	(e) The remaining sections shall take effect on passage.
