Dr. Barcelow, per your request I can answer your questions as follows:

- 1-) Louisiana passed a law in June of 2014 that allowed ODs to perform both lid and laser surgery procedures.
- 2-) As of today 200 Louisiana licensed ODs have been certified to perform these lid and laser surgical procedures.
- 3-) In 2015 ODs in Louisiana performed 1973 laser surgical procedures without a single complaint heard by the board and with zero reported negative outcomes. The number of lid surgeries is not required to be reported. It is expected that the number will go up significantly in 2016.

I hope this is helpful, and if I can be of assistance in any other way, please let me know.
