

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on Human Services to which was referred House Bill No.  
3 26 entitled “An act relating to restricting retail and Internet sales of electronic  
4 cigarettes, liquid nicotine, and tobacco paraphernalia in Vermont” respectfully  
5 reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the bill be  
6 amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu  
7 thereof the following:

8 Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 1002(g) is amended to read:

9 (g) No person shall engage in the retail sale of tobacco products, tobacco  
10 substitutes, substances containing nicotine or otherwise intended for use with a  
11 tobacco substitute, or tobacco paraphernalia in the State unless the person is a  
12 licensed wholesale dealer as defined in 32 V.S.A. § 7702 or has purchased the  
13 tobacco products, tobacco substitutes, substances containing nicotine or  
14 otherwise intended for use with a tobacco substitute, or tobacco paraphernalia  
15 from a licensed wholesale dealer.

16 Sec. 2. 7 V.S.A. § 1010(b) is amended to read:

17 (b) No person shall cause cigarettes, roll-your-own tobacco, little cigars, ~~or~~  
18 snuff, tobacco substitutes, substances containing nicotine or otherwise intended  
19 for use with a tobacco substitute, or tobacco paraphernalia, ordered or  
20 purchased by mail or through a computer network, telephonic network, or

1 other electronic network, to be shipped to anyone other than a licensed  
2 wholesale dealer or retail dealer in this State.

3 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
