In order to prevent or reduce unintended pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases, each school district shall make available to all students in its secondary schools, free of charge, barrier method over-the-counter contraceptive devices and products. School district administrative teams shall, in consultation with school district nursing staff, determine the best method to make contraceptives available to students.

In order to prevent or reduce unintended pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases, each school district shall make available to all students in grades X through 12, free of charge, condoms and XX. Condoms must be placed in locations that are safe and readily accessible for students, minimally in the School Nurses office, AA, BB, etc.
