

Uses of PNA and Charges for Common Services

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Personal Expenses for Nursing Home Residents (Examples)

Clothing/shoes

Dentures, Glasses, hearing aides

Hearing aid batteries

Magazines and other reading materials

Personal crafts or hobbies (e.g. yarn)

Stationary, cards, postage

Gifts (e.g. for grandchildren)

Toiletries (shampoo, soap, tissues, lotions, toothpaste, mouthwash, denture adhesive, etc.) - if you don't like what's provided, and what's provided is the cheapest no name available

Personal comfort items, including notions, novelties, confections/candies, soda, alcohol

Cosmetic and grooming items: shaving lotion, make up, hairbrush

Social events and entertainment offered off premises and outside the scope of the regular facility activities program (e.g. meal out)

Flowers and plants

AIR Conditioning charge, in some facilities

Pet supplies / wild bird seed

Massage

Electronics

Transportation (non medical related)
