2 § 5103. JURISDICTION

3 (c)(1) Except as otherwise provided by this title and by subdivision (2) of
4 this subsection, jurisdiction over a child shall not be extended beyond the
5 child's 18th birthday.

6 (2)(A) Jurisdiction over a child with a pending delinquency may be
7 extended until six months beyond the child's 19th birthday if the child was 16
8 or 17 years of age when he or she committed the offense.

9 (B) In no case shall custody of a child 18 years of age or older be
10 retained by or transferred to the Commissioner for Children and Families.

11 (C) Jurisdiction over a child in need of care or supervision shall not be
12 extended beyond the child's 18th birthday.

13 (D) ~~Repealed.~~ Jurisdiction over a youthful offender shall not extend
14 beyond the youth's 22nd birthday.

15 (E) Jurisdiction over a child may be extended until the child's 22nd
16 birthday if the child is alleged to have committed a listed crime as defined in
17 13 V.S.A. § 5301 after attaining the age of 14 but before attaining the age of
18 18.
