



NASA, NOAA Data Show 2016 Warmest Year on Record Globally







RECOMMENDATIONS: Changes to Act 250 to Respond to and Help Address Climate Change



RECOMMENDATIONS:

Criterion 1: Air and Water Pollution

- Support specifically adding greenhouse gas emissions as currently in draft
- Recommend adding that any new development complies with our statutory greenhouse gas emission reduction goals: 10 V.S.A. §
 578



RECOMMENDATIONS: Criterion 1(D): Floodways

• We support the Act 250 Commission's recommendations to enhance protections for flood hazard areas and river corridors
