I would like to affirm my support, as Lt. Governor, in honoring the Abenaki's long standing claims to their Hunting and Fishing Rights in Vermont as described by the Attorney General's support letter dated February 5th, 2020. I appreciate the Attorney General's legal opinion that these rights to hunt and fish without restriction were codified and preserved in deeds, land grants, and treaties involving lands that are now known as the State of Vermont. Along with legal justification, I think this is the right thing to do.

I hope the General Assembly grants Vermont's State-recognized Native American Indian tribes access to free hunting and fishing licenses. It is time to honor the promises of our past while providing a means for the original Vermonters to continue to sustain their way of life.
