4	(a) When satisfied as to the condition and use of the vehicle, the
5	Commissioner shall issue and may revoke, for cause, permits for sirens or and
6	colored signal lamps in the following manner:
7	(1) Sirens, or blue or blue and signal lamps, red signal lamps, white
8	signal lamps, or a combination of these thereof, may be authorized for all law
9	enforcement vehicles owned or leased by a law enforcement agency, a certified
10	law enforcement officer, or the Vermont Criminal Justice Training Council. If
11	the applicant is a constable, the application shall be accompanied by a
12	certification by the town clerk that the applicant is the duly elected or
13	appointed constable and attesting that the town has not voted to limit the
14	constable's authority to engage in enforcement activities under 24 V.S.A. §
15	1936a.
16	(2) Sirens and red or red and white signal lamps may be authorized for
17	all ambulances, fire apparatus and other emergency medical service (EMS)
18	vehicles, vehicles owned or leased by a fire department, vehicles used solely in
19	rescue operations, or vehicles owned or leased by, or provided to, volunteer

firefighters and voluntary rescue squad members, including a vehicle owned by

a volunteer's employer when the volunteer has the written authorization of the

1	employer to use the vehicle for emergency fire or rescue activities. A single
2	blue signal lamp may be authorized for all ambulances, other EMS vehicles,
3	and vehicles owned or leased by a fire department or rescue squad
4	organization, provided that the Commissioner shall require the lamp to be
5	mounted so as to be visible primarily from the rear of the vehicle and only
6	engaged when the vehicle is stopped.
7	(3) No vehicle may be authorized a permit for more than one of the
8	combinations described in subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection.
9	(4) No motor vehicle, other than one owned by the applicant, shall be
10	issued a permit until the Commissioner has recorded the information regarding
11	both the owner of the vehicle and the applicant for the permit.
12	(5) Upon application to the Commissioner, the Commissioner may issue
13	a single permit for all the vehicles owned or leased by the applicant.
14	(6) Sirens and red or red and white signal lamps, or sirens and blue or
15	blue and white signal lamps, may be authorized for restored emergency or
16	enforcement vehicles used for exhibition purposes. Sirens and lamps
