We support the language that was used in last year's session for H808 written by Helena Gardner which is as follows:

§ 3506. OPERATION; PROHIBITED ACTS;

HEADGEAR

- (a) A person may shall only operate an all-terrain vehicle, or permit an all-terrain vehicle owned by him or her or under his or her control to be operated, in accordance with this chapter
- (16) Unless the operator and all passengers wear upon their heads a properly secured protective headgear of a type approved by the Commissioner, if the ATV is operated at locations where the ATV is required to be registered and display a TAD under section 3502 of this title
