7	addresses at least the following:
8	(1) how telecommuting practices have changed in the State in response

12	generated by telecommuting from April 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020;
13	(4) an estimate of the annual expenses and savings to employers and
14	employees that could be generated by greater utilization of telecommuting
15	starting in calendar year 2021;
16	(5) an estimate of the statewide reduction in single-occupancy pleasure-
17	car trips, where a single-occupancy pleasure-car trip means a pleasure car, as
18	defined in 23 V.S.A. § 4(28), that is only occupied by the operator, attributable
19	to telecommuting due to COVID-19 from April 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020;

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1	(6) an estimate of the annual statewide reduction in single-occupancy
2	pleasure-car trips that could be generated by greater utilization of
3	telecommuting starting in calendar year 2021; and
4	(7) recommendations on ways to increase the use of telecommuting in
5	the State.
