10	vehicle which is being drawn at the end of a combination of vehicles, shall be
11	equipped with at least two taillamps mounted on the rear, except that one
12	taillamp shall be allowed on any vehicle equipped with only one when it was
13	manufactured.

(b) Either a taillamp or a separate lamp shall be so constructed and placed as to illuminate with a white light all parts of the rear registration number plate on the vehicle so that all the numerals, letters, and marks on the plate are clearly visible and legible for at least 50 feet from the rear of the vehicle. This subsection may be enforced only if a law enforcement officer has detained the operator of a motor vehicle for another suspected traffic violation. An operator shall not be subject to a civil penalty for operating a vehicle in violation of this

1	subsection unless the operator is required to pay a penalty for the primary
2	violation.
