2 Representative Till of Jericho moves that the House propose to the Senate
3 that the bill be amended by adding a new section to be Sec. 31a before the
4 reader assistance heading for Sec. 32 to read as follows:

5 Sec. 31a. REPORTING BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

6 The Department of Motor Vehicles, in consultation with the Vermont
7 Criminal Justice Training Council, shall submit a written report to the House
8 and Senate Committees on Transportation and on Judiciary on or before the
9 15th day of January in 2022, 2023, and 2024 containing, for the prior State
10 fiscal year:

11 (1) the total number of traffic stops broken out by race of the driver
12 involved in the traffic stop; and

13 (2) the following information for all traffic stops involving safety belts
14 not worn by persons 18 years of age or over:

15 (A) the age, gender, and race of the driver involved in the traffic stop;

16 (B) the reason for the traffic stop;

17 (C) the type of search conducted, if any;

18 (D) the evidence located, if any;

19 (E) the outcome of the traffic stop, including whether:

20 (i) a written warning was issued,

21 (ii) a citation for a civil ticket was issued;

1 (iii) a citation or arrest for a misdemeanor or a felony occurred; or

2 (iv) no subsequent action was taken;

3 (F) summary data broken out by age, gender, race, and outcome of
4 the traffic stop where the reason for the stop was the primary enforcement of a
5 person 18 years of age or over not wearing a safety belt; and

6 (G) summary data broken out by age, gender, race, and outcome of
7 the traffic stop where the reason for the stop was for any reason other than the
8 primary enforcement of a person 18 years of age or over not wearing a safety
9 belt.
