3 Anthony of Barre City, Brennan of Colchester, Canfield of Fair Haven,  
4 Donovan of Burlington, Kornheiser of Brattleboro, Masland of Thetford,  
5 Scheu of Middlebury, and Young of Greensboro move that the bill be amended  
6 in Sec. 2 (Education Fund deficit), by striking out the section in its entirety and  
7 inserting a new Sec. 2 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 2. EDUCATION FUND DEFICIT; REPAYMENT

9 If a deficit in the Education Fund is projected or created for fiscal year  
10 2021, it is the intent of the General Assembly to address the deficit as follows:

11 (1) using federal funds to the greatest extent possible;

12 (2) applying reversions;

13 (3) drawing down the stabilization reserve;

14 (4) using other sources of revenue;

15 (5) reducing costs;

16 (6) borrowing pursuant to Sec. 3 of this act; and

17 (7) using any other source of funding, including making appropriations

18 from the General Fund or other funds.
