


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2019 Cybersecurity Legislation

As of Sept. 19, 2019

At least 43 states and Puerto Rico <u>introduced or considered</u> close to 300 bills or resolutions that deal significantly with cybersecurity. Some of the key cybersecurity issues considered in legislatures included:

- Appropriating funds for improved security in government
- Addressing cybersecurity threats to elections (see NCSL's <u>State Elections Legislation Database</u> for other types of elections security and elections-related legislation)
- Requiring government agencies to implement training and security policies and practices
- Creating cybersecurity task forces, commissions or studies
- Targeting cyber threats such as ransomware or other computer crimes
- Addressing cybersecurity within the insurance industry or cybersecurity insurance for government
- Providing for the confidentiality of government cybersecurity information and plans by exempting it from public records laws
- Encouraging cybersecurity training, education and workforce development.
- Studying the use of blockchain for cybersecurity
- Requiring the private sector to improve security practices
- Addressing the security of connected devices (or the Internet of Things (IoT)).



2019 Enacted State Legislation Related to Cybersecurity

As of Sept. 16, 2019

Summary: In at least 31 states, 80 cybersecurity-related bills were enacted or adopted in 2019. Those states include Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Indiana, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Minnesota, Mississippi, Montana, North Carolina, North Dakota, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, Nevada, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Texas, Virginia, Vermont, Washington, and West Virginia.

Key trends in *enacted* legislation this year are in the following areas:

- Improving government security practices.
- Addressing cybersecurity threats to elections (see NCSL's Elections data base for other types of <u>elections</u> <u>security</u>-related legislation).
- Providing for the confidentiality of government cybersecurity plans and practices by exempting them from public records laws.
- Relating to cybersecurity insurance, including enacting laws based on the <u>NAIC Insurance Data Security</u>
 <u>Model Law</u>, which establishes a comprehensive regulatory framework requiring insurers to implement information security programs.
- Approving studies or task forces to investigate the use of blockchain/distributed ledger technology for cybersecurity.
