

AMO SERVICES*

With approximately \$8 million, VAN members provide to Vermont communities:

- 24 Studio locations
- 81 commercial-free channels
- Nearly 200 jobs
- 18,000 hours of local programming every year
- Over \$1,000,000 in equipment for use by the public
