

TO THE HONORABLE SENATE

The Committee on Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs to which was referred Senate Bill No. S. 240, entitled "An act relating to recruiting new remote workers and new relocating workers"

respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the bill be amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 1. REMOTE WORKERS; NEW WORKER RELOCATION
INCENTIVE PROGRAM; FUNDING AUTHORITY

Of the amounts appropriated to the Agency of Commerce and Community Development in 2019 Acts and Resolves No. 80, Sec. 20 for the New Worker Relocation Incentive Program, the Agency may use not more than 50 percent of the funds in fiscal year 2020 to continue providing grants through the New Remote Worker Grant Program created in 2018 Acts and Resolves No. 197, Sec. 1, as amended by 2019 Acts and Resolves No. 80, Sec. 15.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
