(D)(i) All Except as otherwise provided in subdivision (ii) of this subdivision (17)(D), all wages which that fall within the "base period" of valid claims under this section subdivision (17) shall not be available for reuse in qualifying for any subsequent benefit years under section 1338 or 1318 of this title.

unemployment compensation benefits in relation to his or her current claim and who is determined to be ineligible for benefits pursuant to subsection 1343(a) of this chapter because he or she is unable to work due to an accident or injury resulting in a temporary total disability for which the claimant is eligible to receive workers' compensation benefits under chapter 9 of this title may withdraw his or her claim for unemployment compensation benefits.

Notwithstanding subdivision (i) of this subdivision (17)(D), all wages that fell within the base period used to establish the withdrawn claim shall be available for use by the claimant in establishing a claim pursuant to subsection 1338(d) of this chapter.
