6	First: In Sec. 5, tax increment financing project development; pilot
7	program, by striking out subsection (b) in its entirety and inserting in lieu
8	thereof a new subsection (b) to read:
9	(b) Pilot Program. Beginning on January 1, 2021 and ending on
10	December 31, 2023, the Vermont Economic Progress Council is authorized to
11	approve not more than six tax increment financing projects, provided that there
12	shall be not more than one project per municipality.
13	Second: By striking out Secs. 6–10 and their reader assistance headings in
14	their entireties and inserting in lieu thereof new Secs. 6-7 and reader assistance
15	headings to read as follows:
16	* * * Downtown Tax Credit; Study * * *
17	Sec. 6. DOWNTOWN TAX CREDIT EXPANSION; STUDY
18	On or before September 1, 2020, the Agency of Commerce and Community
19	Development shall report to the Senate Committees on Finance and on
20	Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs and to the House
21	Committees on Ways and Means and on Commerce and Economic

1	Development on any dilution in the amounts of individual downtown tax
2	credits awarded due to the statutory expansion of the districts eligible for such
3	credits. The report shall also describe any steps taken by the Vermont
4	Downtown Development Board to minimize any dilution of individual credits
5	due to statutory expansion.

7	Sec. 7. APPROPRIATION
8	In fiscal year 2021, the amount of \$1,000,000.00 is appropriated from the
9	General Fund to the Secretary of State to complete the work of the steering
10	committee created in 2018 Acts and Resolves No. 196, Sec. 1, as amended by
11	2019 Acts and Resolves No. 80, Sec. 13, to design and implement a one-stop
12	business portal for businesses, entrepreneurs, and citizens to provide
13	information about starting and operating a business in Vermont.
