4 metering definition) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 4  
5 and a Sec. 5 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 4. 30 V.S.A. § 8002 is amended to read:

7 § 8002. DEFINITIONS

8 As used in this chapter:

10 (10) “Group net metering system” means a net metering system serving  
11 more than one customer, or a single customer with multiple electric meters,  
12 located within the service area of the same retail electricity provider. Various  
13 buildings owned by municipalities, including water and wastewater districts,  
14 fire districts, villages, school districts, and towns, may constitute a group net  
15 metering system. ~~A union or district school facility shall~~ Any building owned  
16 by a public school, as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(7); an independent school, as  
17 defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(8); a supervisory union, as defined in 16 V.S.A.  
18 § 11(23); a school district, as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(10); a regional career  
19 technical center school district, as defined in 16 V.S.A. §1571; or a joint  
20 contract school, as described in 16 V.S.A. § 571 may be considered in the  
21 same group net metering system or in the same group net metering system with

1 buildings of its member municipalities that are located within the service area  
2 of the same retail electricity provider that serves the facility.

5 § 8010. SELF-GENERATION AND NET METERING

7 (c) In accordance with this section, the Commission shall adopt and  
8 implement rules that govern the installation and operation of net metering  
9 systems.

11 (2) The rules shall include provisions that govern:

12 (A) ~~whether~~ Whether there is a limit on the cumulative plant capacity  
13 of net metering systems to be installed over time and what that limit is, if any;  
14 except that the cumulative capacity of any net metering system attributed to a  
15 group or customer that is a public school, as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(7); an  
16 independent school, as defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(8); a supervisory union, as  
17 defined in 16 V.S.A. § 11(23); a school district, as defined in 16 V.S.A.  
18 § 11(10); a regional career technical center school district, as defined in 16  
19 V.S.A. §1571; or a joint contract school, as described in 16 V.S.A. § 571, shall  
20 not be limited.

2 metering systems and the abandonment of net metering systems;

3 (C) ~~the~~ The respective duties of retail electricity providers and net

7 (E) ~~the~~ The formation of group net metering systems, the resolution  
8 of disputes between group net metering customers and the interconnecting  
9 provider, and the billing, crediting, and disconnection of group net metering
