16	AUTHORIZING DEADLINE EXTENSION, WAIVER OF
17	PENALTIES AND FEES, AND ADJUSTMENT OF MUNICIPAL

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1	(a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, during a declared
2	state of emergency under 20 V.S.A. chapter 1 due to COVID-19, the
3	legislative body of a municipality is authorized to:
4	(1) extend or establish a new time and method of payment for the
5	municipal property tax and statewide education property tax collected by the
6	municipality from taxpayers;
7	(2) establish a grace period for, decrease, or waive any penalty, interest,
8	or fee imposed on taxpayers for the late payment of the municipal property tax
9	or statewide education property tax collected by the municipality; and
10	(3) reduce the municipal property tax rate.
11	(b) The acts permitted by subsection (a) may be adopted by majority vote
12	of the legislative body of a municipality and shall expire on January 1, 2021.
13	(c) This section shall apply only to property taxes collected by a
14	municipality from the taxpayers. This section shall not apply to any deadlines,
15	penalties, or interest imposed on a municipality with respect to payment of the
