7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 2 V.S.A. § 12 is amended to read:
13	§ 12. LEGISLATIVE ELECTIONS; UNIFORM BALLOTS
14	(a) Whenever there is a known contested election for Speaker of the House
15	of Representatives, or for President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and in
16	elections by the joint assembly of the Legislature General Assembly, the
17	Secretary of State shall prepare a ballot for each office, listing the names of the
18	known candidates for the office in the alphabetical order of their surnames and
19	leaving thereon sufficient blank spaces to take care of any nominations from
20	the floor.

1	(b) A candidate for office shall, not later than one week preceding the
2	election, notify the Secretary of State in writing of his or her candidacy,
3	naming the particular office. If he or she fails so to notify the Secretary of
4	State, his or her name shall not be printed on the ballot. No ballot may be used
5	other than the official ballot provided by the Secretary of State.
6	(c)(1) A candidate for Adjutant and Inspector General shall:
7	(A) be a resident of Vermont;
8	(B) have attained the rank of lieutenant colonel (O-5) or above;
9	(C) be a current member of the U.S. Army, the U.S. Air Force, the
10	U.S. Army Reserve, the U.S. Air Force Reserve, the Army National Guard, or
11	the Air National Guard or be eligible to return to active service in the Army
12	National Guard or the Air National Guard; and
13	(D) be a graduate of a Senior Service College, currently be enrolled
14	in a Senior Service College, or be eligible to be enrolled in a Senior Service
15	College during the biennium in which the candidate would first be appointed.
16	(2) A candidate for Adjutant and Inspector General shall, at the time he
17	or she notifies the Secretary of State of his or her candidacy pursuant to
18	subsection (b) of this section, certify under oath to the Secretary that he or she
19	meets the qualifications set forth in subdivision (1) of this subsection.
20	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
21	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
