

1 TO THE HONORABLE SENATE:

2 The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred Senate Bill  
3 No. 335 entitled “An act relating to universal access to afterschool programs”  
4 respectfully reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the  
5 bill be amended in Sec. 2 (Task Force for Universal Afterschool Access) by  
6 striking out subsections (g) and (h) in their entirety and inserting in lieu  
7 thereof the following:

8 (g) Reimbursement.

9 (1) For attendance at meetings during adjournment of the General  
10 Assembly, a legislative member of the Task Force serving in his or her  
11 capacity as a legislator shall be entitled to per diem compensation and  
12 reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 2 V.S.A. § 406 for not more than  
13 six meetings. The Legislative Branch shall administer reimbursement for  
14 legislative members of the Task Force.

15 (2) Members of the Task Force who are not employees of the State of  
16 Vermont and who are not otherwise compensated or reimbursed for their  
17 attendance shall be entitled to per diem compensation and reimbursement of  
18 expenses pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 1010 for not more than six meetings. The  
19 Agency of Human Services shall administer reimbursement for the Task Force  
20 members specified in this subdivision from funds available from the  
21 appropriation made in 2018 (Special Session) Acts and Resolves No. 11,

1     Sec. C.106.2, specifically from the funds allocated for afterschool programing  
2     in the spending plan for this appropriation adopted by the Joint Fiscal  
3     Committee at its July 27, 2018 meeting.
