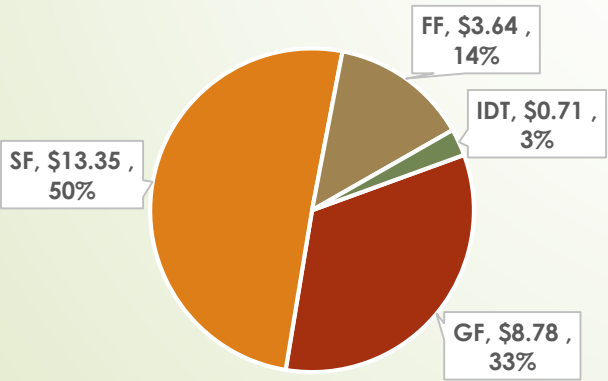
## FY 2020 Governor's Recommend

### Budget

**MISSION:** Facilitate, support and encourage the growth and viability of agriculture while protecting the working landscape, human health, animal health, plant health, consumers and the environment.

**VISION:** Help develop a safe, secure, ecologically responsive, profitable and fair local foods system for Vermont and Vermont customers which will enable Vermont to be a leader and participant in the global food system. The Agency will do this by assuming a leadership position important to the evolving food system, through access to and the application of resources (human, financial, social and environmental) and by supporting the creation of new opportunities.

## FY 2020 SUMMARY & HIGHLIGHTS

- \$394,749 GF increase over FY 2019 appropriated;
- 5 Exempt, 123 Classified positions;
- Multi-year and on-line licensing & registration for 96% of agency programs will be live by end of CY19;
- FSCP Division completed grant on Food Armor program
- Ag Dev grant management continuous improvement project reducing days from application to completed grant.
- PHARM Division excited about explosion of hemp industry
- Water Quality Division interacting with farmers on Nutrient Management Commission
- VAEL Laboratory completed and opening in Randolph, VT



# Agency of Agriculture FY'20 Budget

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## The Agency is comprised of six appropriations

- Administration
- Food Safety, Consumer Protection
- Agricultural Development
- Public Health & Agricultural Resource Management
- Vermont Agricultural and Environmental Laboratory
- Agricultural Water Quality

## ➤ The Agency budget maintains staffing and operations to ensure the main areas of focus for the Agency.

- Water Quality
- Regulation of feed, seed, fertilizer and pesticide and burgeoning hemp industry
- Jobs – Agricultural Development, New Businesses and Markets, Fair Marketplace
- Food Safety and Consumer Protection – Food Safety Modernization Act, Animal Health, Dairy, Meat and Weights and Measures

## ➤ Internal service costs such as Fee for Space, insurances, VISION, etc., are allocated throughout the Agency, generally based on number of positions.

# Agency of Agriculture FY'20 Budget

## 4 Areas of Increase:

- \$1,540,000: Increase in Statewide Clean Water Fund Grants
- \$ 610,000: Annualized Pay Act; \$255,016 = General Fund Portion
- \$ 350,000: \$200,000 Water Quality from DEC (NEIWPC) and \$150,000 Arbovirus from VDH (CDC) – Interdepartmental Transfers
- \$ 300,000: Internal Service Fund Net of Prior Lease Costs; New VAEL Nets \$200,000 increase – All Funds
- \$ 245,800: Contractual Services; Hemp Program Expansion & Fee Changes – Spec Fund
- \$ 235,660: Federal State Marketing Improvement Program and Acer Maple Grants – Federal Fund
- \$ 149,890: Two positions – Ag Dev Spec (JFO#2908) & Ag Resource Management Spec (Position Pool) – Federal & Spec Funds

## Areas of Decrease:

- \$(1,300,000): VT Ag & Environmental Lab Completion – Spec & Fed Funds
- \$ (438,265): Lab Info Management System purchased – Spec Funds
- \$ (75,000): Drug Tissue Residue (Food Armour) Grant Complete – Federal Fund
- \$ (60,000): Section 248 – no temp needed and lower operating costs – Spec Fund

OBJECTIVE: Per 6 VSA Sections 1082-1085 the Mosquito Control Program exists to conduct statewide surveillance of biting arthropod habitat and provide financial and technical assistance to the Mosquito Control Districts (MCDs) with their nuisance mosquito control efforts.

# Agency of Agriculture FY'20 Budget

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## **New Initiatives**

- Expansion of Hemp Program: Laboratory Certification and Processing Program
  - As required by Statute – Rule making underway
  - Fee Bill Request for more resources
  - Hemp growing with change to Federal Farm Bill
  - Economic Development for Vermont Agriculture

## **PIVOT Initiatives**

- On-Line Licensing and Registration – Requirements have been signed off on by the Agency; contractor is working on development and design – Implementation planned for last part of 2019
- Ability to accept credit card payments – System went live January 31, 2019. Rolling out to the public in the very near future.
- Engineering Lean Process
  - Internal Staff worked on Agricultural Engineering and technical assistance to farmers. Mapping process as Ag Engineering Section has grown in number of employees.
  - Documentation of interaction with farmers, reporting on projects and working on timeliness of response from application through project completion.

# Agency of Agriculture FY'20 Budget

- ▶ Challenges
  - ▶ Continued growth in meat slaughter and processing
  - ▶ Explosive Growth in Hemp
  - ▶ Building a new produce regulatory program
  - ▶ Continued growth in water quality – working with an ever greater number of farmers
    - ▶ Greater inspection and reports
    - ▶ Greater enforcement
    - ▶ Greater need for technical assistance
    - ▶ Pleased to have 8 engineers to assist farmers with implementing practices to protect water quality

Speak to new initiatives expected to have future impact.</p> <p>The Food Safety and Consumer Protection Division (FSCP) of the Agency of Agriculture, Food and Markets performs regulatory and technical assistance work in order to meet its objective of advancing a safe and secure food supply within a marketplace that provides fair and equal access to consumers and processors. The measures chosen for the performance based budgeting initiative were picked because they are the easiest to quantify and represent a large portion of the regulatory work performed by Division employees. The number of licenses, registrations, and permits overseen by the Division indicates the scope of businesses falling under the regulatory authority of the Division. The number of inspections indicates the activities undertaken by staff to ensure compliance and provide outreach services to constituents. Administrative actions taken above the level of the field staff demonstrate the follow-through by the Division management to ensure the Division is meeting its objective.</p> <p>Although these measures are objective, there are nuances associated with the data the reviewer should keep in mind when attempting to draw conclusions from the information. The definition of an "inspection" is different for each of the four sections of the Division; one inspection completed by Meat Inspection Program staff does not constitute the same scope or type of work as one inspection performed by an Animal Health section employee. A daily slaughter inspection performed by a Meat Inspection Program employee is comprised of multiple sub-inspections including procedures that vary from day to day, while a livestock dealer inspection performed by an Animal Health section employee consists of reviewing a defined set of parameters to ensure compliance at one snapshot in time.</p> <p>32 The Division is tracking the number of compliance activities completed that go beyond the level of the field staff, and these include Letters of Warning, Notices of Violation, Assurances of Discontinuance, etc. Again, this is a quantifiable measure, but the data provided does not capture the intangible amount of technical assistance and proactive compliance work done by the managers and field staff during almost every interaction with regulated constituents, including that which occurs during phone and email communication, consumer complaint investigations, and site/facility inspections. As a result, the data provided grossly underestimates the total amount of compliance work completed by the Division on an ongoing basis.</p> <p>The FSCP Division might be unique in that the measures chosen for this project are entirely linked to Vermont's private business sector, which the Division does not control. This makes it difficult to provide accurate data projections for future fiscal years for all three measures. Although the Division strives to meet its goal of ensuring 100% of the individuals and businesses operating in Vermont under Division jurisdiction are appropriately licensed/registered/permited and inspected in accordance with statutory requirements, attaching accurate projected numbers to this is not possible. The compliance activities anticipated for completion during any given year also correlate with the number of businesses in existence at that time and so can only be fully known in retrospect.</p>

For FY15 and FY16 Grantees we have collected Client Surveys from Service Provider Grantees to measure impact to businesses from our investments in Service Providers; whereas FY13, FY14 and this year's Service Provider Grantees did not contribute data to these RBA Results. Business grant projects are currently in progress, so survey and data aggregation will be processed at the end of the 2018 calendar year for FY18 information. For gross income and increase in jobs, we are reporting our RBAs in aggregate, meaning, we are reporting here changes from the implementation of a reporting grantee's working lands project through calendar year 2017. We are reporting in aggregate so we can adequately see the changes in our RBA metrics due to the implementation of the project.
