




Incomes of the top 1 percent increased more than everyone else's Cumulative change in income, top 1% and bottom 99%, 1979-2015


99% Average income, top 1% and bottom 99%, 2015


Two-thirds of the benefits go to the top 20% of Vermont taxpayers Share of tax benefits from Tax Cuts and Job Act, by income group, 2018






Federal tax cuts have helped the top for 18 years

Shares of Federal Tax Cuts Going to Each Income Group, 2001 Through 2018





Pay languished for all education levels Median hourly wage, by education level, adjusted for inflation, 2007-2017







Growth in median wage, housing and child care costs,* adjusted for inflation, 2006-2016




*The housing cost is for rural housing for a single person; the child care cost is a weighted average of the cost of care in all counties except Chittenden.

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
Vermonters' incomes fell in 2017 Vermont median household income, adjusted for inflation, 2007-2017




Vermonters of color experienced higher rates of poverty Poverty rate by race, 2017



Vermont's child poverty rate is higher than its neighbors' Child poverty rate, New England states and U.S., 2017







3SquaresVT recipients, annual average, 2007-2017






Vermonters using 3SquaresVT, by county, August 2018

Housing takes a huge bite of minimum wage Share of full-time minimum wage income required for rural housing for a single person, 2002-2016



Number of work hours per week at minimum wage required to pay annual tuition, fees, and room and board at Vermont institutions, 1980 and 2016


