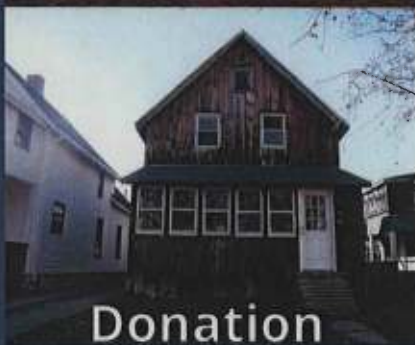
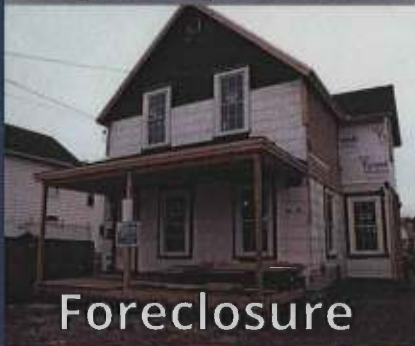
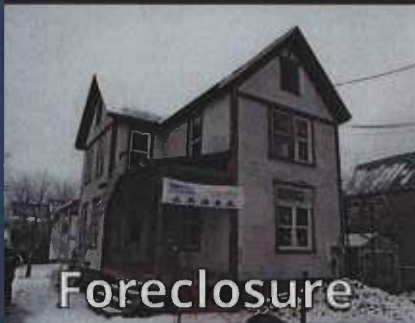


# Work Done in Rutland's Northwest Neighborhood

## The Updates

### 39 Pine St.

Renovated into a 3-bedroom single family home with a modern floorplan and open concept kitchen and living room. Efficiency measures include solar panels, heat pumps, heat pump hot water heater, and weatherization work.

### 128 Library Ave.

Featuring an open floor plan, ENERGY STAR kitchen appliances, and rustic wooden beams. We also salvaged the garage at the end of the driveway and cleared out the now spacious backyard.

### 120 Library Ave.

Featuring a new front porch, additional bathroom, and energy efficient appliances. Only the structure remains of the original building.

### 59 Baxter St.

Features an open floor plan, all new appliances, a new roof, a new foundation, and updated wiring, plumbing, and electrical. Also includes a new furnace.
