8	(a) Study by Vermont Technical College. The Vermont Technical
9	College (VTC) shall study how to best deliver all or a portion of fully
10	accredited VTC associate degree programs at CTE centers in Vermont. The
11	study shall explore the viability of a new program to provide a locally
12	convenient and financially affordable option to high school students and adult
13	learners who want, while still enrolled with their CTE centers, to also enroll in
14	a high-demand, high-skill, industry-specific associate degree offering. VTC
15	shall collaborate with the CTE centers and the Agency of Education in
16	conducting the study. In structuring the study, VTC shall consider:
17	(1) alignment of degree programs with workforce priority needs and
18	career pathways identified by the Agency of Education;
19	(2) coherence with existing, State-supported postsecondary programs for
20	secondary students, such as dual enrollment and early college programs under

1	the flexible pathways laws, including potential impacts to, and alignment with,
2	those programs;
3	(3) sustainable funding models, including costs for students, institutions,
4	and adults;
5	(4) the financial risks of programmatic and funding model changes, with
6	the goals of not negatively impacting the accreditation status or the financial
7	status of any institution, and
8	(5) management of class scheduling and CTE partnerships to ensure
9	access and programmatic success.
10	(b) Reports. On or before December 15, 2019, VTC shall submit a written
11	report to the House and Senate Committees on Education and the State Board
12	of Education with its findings and recommendations from the study required
13	under subsection (a) of this section. If VTC proceeds with the delivery of
14	associate degrees at CTE centers, then, on or before December 15, 2020, VTC
15	shall submit a supplemental written report to the House and Senate Committees
16	on Education and the State Board of Education with its findings and
17	recommendations from this associate degree program.
18	(c) Appropriation. The sum of \$200,000.00 is appropriated for fiscal year
19	2019 from the General Fund to VTC to provide funding for the study required
20	under subsection (a) of this section. VTC may apply funding appropriated
