

# 248a Structure Statistics

Under 30 V.S.A § 248a, companies may, at their discretion, seek a Certificate of Public Good (CPG) from the Vermont Public Service Board (PSB) instead of seeking either an Act 250 permit or local zoning, or both.

Between 2010 and 2016 the PSB issued 566 CPGs pursuant to 248a.

248a authorizes three categories of petitions: full petition, limited size and scope and de minimus. The table below depicts the quantity of orders for the three types.
