Senator MacDonald moves that the bill be amended by adding a Sec. 2 to read as follows:

Sec. 2. 30 V.S.A. § 8002(28) is amended to read:

(28) “Energy transformation project” means an undertaking that provides energy-related goods or services but does not include or consist of the generation of electricity and that results in a net reduction in fossil fuel consumption by the customers of a retail electricity provider and in the emission of greenhouse gases attributable to that consumption. Examples of energy transformation projects may include home weatherization or other thermal energy efficiency measures; air source or geothermal heat pumps; high efficiency heating systems; increased use of biofuels; biomass heating systems; support for transportation demand management strategies; support for electric vehicles or related infrastructure; and infrastructure for the storage of renewable energy on the electric grid. Energy transformation project shall not include an undertaking that is pursuant to a standard business practice that is recognized in the industry and that is supported by actuarial analysis.
