

Potential Revenue Proposals: S.96

- House raised \$7.3 million from following revenues within the Education Fund:
 - \$1.3 million from veterinarian supplies
 - \$6 million from ending exemption on cloud based software
- House changed the Meals and Rooms percentage split to Education Fund from 25% to 21%. 4% of Meals and Rooms was dedicated to Clean Water Fund
 - \$7.6 million diverted to the Clean Water Fund
