Re: S.233

- 1. This is to provide the position of the Board of Medical Practice (the Board) regarding the portions of S. 233 that apply to the Board. The Board strongly opposes lines 1-4 on page 21 of the "as introduced" version of the bill. The Board has discussed that provision with interested parties and came to an agreement regarding language that the Board will not oppose. That language has been shared with Legislative Council staff. It changes lines 1-4 on page 21 as seen below. Paragraph (2) here would be inserted and paragraph (2) in the "as introduced" version would become (d)(3).
 - (1) The Board shall have an endorsement process that requires not more than three years of practice in good standing in another jurisdiction regardless of whether that jurisdiction has licensing requirements substantially similar to those of this State, so long as the applicant meets the following postgraduate training requirements:
 - (a) A graduate of a U.S. or Canadian medical school accredited by a body that is acceptable to the Board must have successfully completed at least two years of postgraduate training in a U.S. or Canadian program accredited by an organization that is acceptable to the Board; or
 - (b) A graduate of a Board-approved medical school outside the United States or Canada must have successfully completed at least three years of postgraduate training in a U.S. or Canadian program accredited by an organization that is acceptable to the Board.
 - (2) If the Board determines that three years of demonstrated practice in another specific jurisdiction is not adequately protective of the public, it shall provide its rationale to the Commissioner, who may propose any necessary statutory or rule amendments in order to implement more restrictive requirements for endorsement for that jurisdiction.
- 2. The Board does not welcome these proposed changes. The Board believes that the licensing standards used to determine which physicians qualify to practice in Vermont are appropriate and protect Vermont patients. Vermont's standards have not interfered with having a robust physician workforce. With 629 licensed physicians per 100,000 population, Vermont has the third best ratio of all US states. The national ratio is 285 licensed physicians per 100,000 population. This data is from the most recent version of the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB) U.S. Medical Regulatory Trends and Actions, which was published in 2018. Attachment A. The standards at issue are requirements for applicants for physician licenses to have graduated



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from medical school, and for the school to be accredited; for the applicant to have completed at least 2 years of approved graduate medical education (residency) if a graduate of a US or Canadian medical school, and 3 years of approved graduate medical education if a graduate of a medical school outside of the US or Canada; and for the applicant to complete the licensing exams within a limited number of years and attempts. There are states that do not require applicants to have completed medical school, but instead require only 2 years. Attachment B, FSMB table, Requirements for Licensure of U.S. Medical/Osteopathic School Graduates. There are states that require only one year of graduate medical education. And there are states that do not have any limits on the number of years or attempts it takes to pass the United States Medical Licensing Exam. Attachment C, FSMB table, Administration of the U.S. Medical Licensing Examination Step 3: Time Limits for Completion. The Board believes that the current standards for education, training, and passing the USMLE exclude those physicians who are least capable of providing safe, quality care to Vermont patients. The great majority of physicians meet our existing standards, and obviously the standards have not interfered with the ability to have an adequate physician workforce. For those reasons, the Board believes that the best course of action would be not to deny Vermont patients the protection of qualitative licensing standards.

Administration of the U.S. Medical Licensing Examination Step 3: Time Limits for Completion 1
