14	(a) The Agency of Human Services, in collaboration with the Agency of
15	Education, shall complete an inventory of those programs offered in Vermont
16	aimed at preventing youth substance misuse and truancy. The Agencies shall
17	indicate which programs attain the highest success rates and are capable of
18	replication, as well as system and geographic gaps.
19	(b) On or before November 1, 2020, the Agency of Human Services shall
20	submit the completed inventory to the House Committees on Education and on
